BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- For all commercial and residential construction, Additions, alterations, renovation and demolition Both interior and exterior as defined and determined By the city engineer and/or his designees.
- 2. For all fencing, signs, street cuts and alley cuts.
- 3. For Plumbing (excluding repairs), Gas Pipe Test.
- 4. Before a mobile home is placed, set or affixed upon a lot(s), Tract or parcel of land within the city (Section 6-7.2.)
- 5. For roofing, siding, decks and windows
- 6. HVAC installations and replacements of existing units

Building Permits are **NOT** required for the following:

- One-story detached accessory buildings used as tool and Storage sheds, playhouses, etc., provided the area is under 200 square feet as measured at the maximum exterior wall Dimension.
- Sidewalks and driveways
- Painting, papering, tiling, carpeting, cabinets, counter tops
 And similar finish work.
- Although a project may not require a building permit,
 Other requirements may apply. It is recommended you contact
 The Building Department before beginning any project.

- > After Poles, Piers, Trenches or basement areas are excavated
- > Any required Forms and Re-bar
- Plumbing, Mechanical, Gas Inspection
 - ➤ Rough In of Plumbing, Mechanical, Gas shall be made prior to covering or concealment, before fixtures or appliances are set or installed and prior framing. Exception: Backfilling of ground-source Heat Pump Loop Systems
- Frame and Masonry Inspection
 - ➤ Floor Systems, Wall Framing, Roof Systems, Fire stopping & Draft stopping, required Bracing, ventilation
- Wall Coverings and Roof Coverings
 - Exterior fasteners to sheeting, house wrap, roof underlayment, window tape, siding & roof coverings to be applied,
 - ➤ Interior sheetrock(fasteners, ½ Type X or 5/8 type X if texturing on ceilings) before it is taped and finished
- Other inspections may be require to ascertain compliance with code
 - > Exhaust Fans in Bathroom (Vented to Outside)
 - > Smoke Detectors in all bedrooms, hallways
 - > Dryer Vents to Outside
- **❖** Final Inspection
 - Plumbing fixtures, gas piping (Test),HVAC, fire prevention, test on smoke detectors
